Position: Director and/or Assistant Director

Robin's Nest Children's Home ("the Nest") is seeking candidates who may be interested in serving as an on-site director or assistant director.

The Nest is located near Montego Bay, Jamaica, and continuously cares for up to 35 children, ranging in age from birth through adolescence.

Currently, there are two on-site directors managing the daily operations of the Nest, as well as three managers, POD moms, teachers, and several other staff members. Typically, there are short-term and/or long-term interns providing support at the Nest as well.

The role of a Director and/or Assistant Director is to support the Nest in providing a nurturing, loving, safe, Christ-centered atmosphere in which all children can grow at their own speed - physically, mentally, and spiritually - so they may develop their own individual gifts, talents and abilities and become the person whom God intended.

A Director or Assistant Director is expected to live on-site at the Nest, generally commit to serving in this capacity for a minimum of two years, and will work collaboratively with the Board of Directors, Co-Directors, Assistant Directors, staff, and interns to support the Nest's mission and manage daily operations.

First and foremost, we are seeking individuals who are committed to following Jesus Christ, have a heart for children, possess a strong mix of professional and leadership qualifications, and who feel called to serve in the mission field.

The ideal leader has excellent interpersonal and organizational skills, proven leadership skills and experience, a clear understanding and respect for cultural diversity, and the ability to develop relationships with children, staff, supporters, community and government leaders.

The role of a Director or Assistant Director requires strong skills in some or all of these areas:

- Staff management
- Budget oversight and management
- Facilities management
- Project and team coordination
- Community and financial development
- Strategic planning

Knowledge and experience in any of the following areas is also helpful:

- Child Development
- Counseling
- Social Work
- Ministry/Mission
- Healthcare
